

Transport Agency toll roads



You can expect to save around 9 minutes by taking the **Northern Gateway Toll Road** at non-peak times. The 7 kilometre toll road offers motorists an alternative to the Hibiscus Coast Highway through Orewa.

You can expect to save around 12 minutes by taking the **Tauranga Eastern Link Toll Road** at non-peak times. Located between Papamoa and Paengaroa the 15 kilometre toll road offers an alternative to the Te Puke Highway, through Te Puke.

You can expect to save around 7 minutes at non-peak times by taking the 5 kilometre **Takitimu Drive Toll Road**. The alternative routes are via Cameron Road or Cambridge Road / Moffat Road.

Save an average 9 minutes travel time | \$2.20 (motorcycle) | \$2.20 (car) | \$4.40 (trailer) *One way

Save an average 12 minutes travel time | \$2.00 (motorcycle) | \$2.00 (car) | \$5.00 (trailer) *One way

Save an average 7 minutes travel time | \$1.80 (motorcycle) | \$1.80 (car) | \$4.80 (trailer) *One way

There is no additional charge for towing a caravan or trailer.
