**Rupert Clark Road - A new street for a deserving fellow**

In recognition of his services to the community Mr Rupert Clark was awarded the Member of the NZ Order of Merit in 2007. He was renowned for his work with charities, war veterans and sports, particularly rugby, where he was a founding member of the Marist Rugby Club in Whangarei.

Mr and Mrs Clark were residents of 146 Kamo Road from the 1950s until his house was purchased by Transit NZ in the mid-90s as the entrance to the bypass. In acknowledgment for his commitment to Whangarei and Northland it was decided that the new road was to be named Rupert Clark Road.
