



Intersections improvements between Selwyn Avenue and Wilson Avenue include widening of the state highway to four lanes to improve traffic flows and reduce congestion at peak times.

Traffic signals at both Selwyn Avenue and Central Avenue will be reconfigured and free left turn lanes installed at the intersections to provide efficient access to and from the city centre.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

- SH1 will be widened to four lanes between Selwyn Avenue and Central Avenue
- A free left turn lane will be constructed at Selwyn Avenue for southbound traffic exiting the state highway
- Free left turn lanes will be constructed at Central Avenue
- Traffic signals at both intersections will be upgraded
- Median barriers will be installed on the state highway at each intersection approach

MANDER PARK

Trees on the edge of Mander Park are scheduled to be removed next month. The 11 trees include London Plane, Oak and Puriri.

Representatives from local iwi conducted a site blessing in 2011 and have identified trees of significance. These trees will be returned to the iwi once they have been removed from the park.

Seeds collected from the trees in 2011 have been propagated and are currently being gifted to the Whangarei community. Replacement trees will be planted during May-June 2012 to ensure trees are well established before physical works commence.
