



# WHANGAREI IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT OVERVIEW

The NZ Transport Agency is working with Whangarei District Council (WDC) to improve the state highway through Whangarei.

In addition to the recently completed Central Avenue intersection improvements as part of the Selwyn Avenue to Wilson Avenue upgrade and current upgrade at the intersection of SH1/14/Maunu Road, the Transport Agency has four intersection improvements projects planned to help manage growing traffic numbers, improve safety and make travel easier for locals and visitors travelling in and around Whangarei.

The remaining projects include intersection upgrades to Kensington Avenue, Selwyn Avenue, Fourth Avenue and Tarawea Road, widening of the state highway and roading improvements from Tarewa Road north to Percy Street. All projects are aimed at helping to ease congestion and support economic growth in and around the city.

The projects support the Urban Growth Strategy for Whangarei District and will create jobs locally. The majority of suppliers and subcontractors will be regionally based and the work will provide a boost to the community.

- Tarewa Road
- SH1/SH14
- Selwyn Avenue to Wilson Avenue
- Wilson Avenue to Fourth Avenue
- Kensington Avenue to Manse Street
